**COLLECTING: Marine Fossils: Stromatolite, Brachiopods, Bryozoans.**

**BRING: Geology Hammer or small scratching tool, bucket. Fossils are loose and easy to pick up.**

Fee: \$125, (12 and under \$90)**



**TRIP:** Travel by canoe through pristine Florida wilderness on the beautiful Peace River to reach some of the most promising fossil collecting areas in Florida.

**COLLECTING:** We will be sifting through gravel deposits in the riverbed to find fossilized teeth and bones of sharks, whales, and mammals such as ancient horses, camels, sloths, mammoths, and mastodon.

**BRING:** Water, packed lunch (small coolers are ok), bags or small bucket for your finds, clothes and shoes that can be worn in water, plus an extra set of dry clothes to change into later, towel, dry bag or ziplock to hold your phone, wallet, etc., hat, sunglasses, sunscreen. You will be walking in sand and gravel, in water, so closed water shoes or dive boots are recommended. Optional: Snorkel, mask, and swim fins. Also, it's a good idea to bring a sweater or jacket. It can sometimes be cool in December, even here in Florida.

**THE FOLLOWING WILL BE PROVIDED BY OUR GUIDE:** Canoes, life vests, shovels, sifting screens, and the required Florida fossil collecting permit (which will cover the whole group).

**FACILITIES:** No facilities.

**REQUIREMENTS:** Be prepared to paddle on scenic, natural rivers and shovel and sift through gravel deposits.

**TERRAIN/SPECIAL CONDITIONS:** We will be in and out of canoes and wading in water. Come prepared to get wet.

**FEE:** \$125 per adult, \$90 for kids 12 and under. Payable to our guide the morning of the trip via cash, check, Venmo, or Zelle.

**REGISTRATION:** Click [here](#) to fill out a registration form. If you register and are unable to attend the trip, **please be considerate** to your fellow rockhounds and let us know as soon as possible so someone on a potential waiting list can take your slot(s).

**CHILDREN (Yes):** Children 5 and older are allowed, but must be supervised by a parent/adult guardian at all times. **NOTE:** There will be 12 canoes and only one child (12 or under) is allowed per canoe. You must register at least one adult per child.

**PETS (No):** Pets are not allowed.

**LODGING:** Hotels, campgrounds, and RV sites are available in the Wauchula area.

### DIRECTIONS AND WHERE TO

**MEET:** We will be leaving from one of several spots, all in the Wauchula vicinity. The exact location will be determined the week of the trip after

evaluating current conditions, and registered attendees will be sent directions at that time.

**CARPOOLING:** The registration form has a place for you to indicate if you **need** a ride; if you can **offer** a ride; or if you would like to **drive or share** a carpool ride. If you choose any of these options, your name, email address, and club name will be shared with other members who also choose one of the options. Then, you can communicate with one another to arrange carpools.
